22. <u>Pogonip East Multi-Use Trail (PK)</u>

Motion carried to: 1) Adopt the Mitigated Negative Declaration, 2) Adopt the Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Plan, 3) Amend the Pogonip Master Plan to include the East Multi-Use Trail and 4) Approve the East Multi-Use Trail Plan and direct staff to begin construction of the trail.

Motion Amended to include the following conditions:

- 1. Implement a Sub-Committee of the Parks and Recreation Commission to advise staff on implementation of the Pogonip Master Plan Amendment, including development of signage of multi-use trails, and review of existing bail schedule for citations.
- 2. Trail signs that include the minimum amount of fines.
- 3. Evaluate signage for bike versus walking trail designations.
- 4. Provide report on amount of costs prior to construction of trail.
- 5. Provide a quarterly report for up to two years to review level of compliance for citations and warnings.
- 6. Provide a timetable for permitting and construction.
- 7. Direct Mayor Lane to meet with the appropriate person from the County to start discussions regarding an alternate bike trail along the rail line from the City to an entrance at Pogonip.
- 8. Establish criteria that will trigger the closure of the trail due to weather conditions.
